# History of the LCMV

- Founded by Chet Fowler & Ronnie Kendall, Senior Pastor of FBC Loganville
- LCMV was formed in January 2006, after seeing the impact of a similar ministry village at First Baptist Church of Leesburg in FL

# What are our community's needs?

- Startling Facts

- Divorce occurs in 55% of first marriages and 65% in second marriages
- Over 100 cases of child abuse reported in Walton county every month
- 80 children currently in foster care in Walton County

# The LCMV Mission

To identify and help to meet the actual emotional, physical, and spiritual needs of our community through programs of rescue, recovery, and Christian compassion.

# Addressing the needs:

- Hope House Counseling Center
  - Individual Counseling
  - Marital Counseling
  - Child Counseling



# Addressing the needs:

- Life Coaches for Kids
  - Faith-based mentoring program



# Addressing the needs:

- **Foster Care Support Center**
  - Continued education for foster parents
  - Resource Center: provides families with clothing, baby items, school supplies, etc.
  - Foster family counseling
- **Supervised Visitation Center**
  - Partnered with Walton County Department of Family & Children's Services

# Possible Future Ministries

- Child Advocacy Center
  - Working in partnership with DFACS, law enforcement, and Children's Healthcare of Atlanta
  - Center will provide forensic testing and care for sexually abused children
  - As many as 100 children per month are currently sent to CHOA at Scottish Rite for these services
  - There are no such facilities in our judicial district
